The Wilmore City Council met in regular session Monday, October 3, 2016 at 6:00 p.m. at Wilmore City Hall with Mayor Harold Rainwater presiding. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Councilmember James moved to approve the minutes of the September 19, 2016 regular meeting; seconded by Councilmember Cooper. There being no discussion, all members voted aye.

Councilmember Brumfield made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Cooper to approve the First Reading of the Real Property 2016 Tax Rate using the compensating property tax rate on real property which is 0.002230. There being no discussion, all members voted aye.

Councilmember Brumfield made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Cooper to approve the First Reading of the Tangible Property 2016 Tax Rate using the same property tax rate on tangible property as last year which is 0.007481. There being no discussion, all members voted aye.

Councilmember Brumfield made a motion, seconded by Councilmember Baier to approve the Second Reading of Ordinance 691-16 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX ON ALL MOTOR VEHICLES BY THE CITY OF WILMORE, KENTUCKY FOR THE YEAR 2017. There being no discussion, all members voted aye.
