

**CITY OF WILMORE MINUTES
JULY 17, 2023**

The Wilmore City Council met in a regular session on Monday, July 17, 2023, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Harold L. Rainwater presiding. Council members present were Jim Brumfield, Kim Deyer, Leonard Fitch, Wes Metcalfe, and David Riel. Attorney Robert L. Gullette III was not present.

The Updated Official Zone Map approval will be considered as an item of Old Business at the Council's next meeting.

Lori Vahle stated that we have no new information on Real & Tangible Property Tax. She will present the information to the Council when it is received.


