

**CITY OF WILMORE MINUTES

The Wilmore City Council met for a regular session on Monday, March 4, 2024, at 6:00 p.m. with Mayor Harold L. Rainwater presiding. Council members present were Leonard Fitch, Jim Brumfield, Kim Deyer, David Riel, Andy Bathje, Wes Metcalfe and Attorney Robert Gullette, Jr.

MAYOR REPORT/PRESENTATIONS

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Councilmember Riel made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Deyer, to approve the Minutes of February 5, 2024. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.

OLD BUSINESS

John Steinmetz, PE with Banks Engineering updated the Council on the Downtown Main Street Project. He stated a meeting with downtown business property owners is scheduled for March 12, 2024.

Jack Stewart, AIA and Shelby Brinker, AIA with Stewart Architecture updated the Council on the first phase of the Granary Restoration Project. The first phase will address water in the basement, update electrical service in the building, secure windows and doors. It will also begin concrete and wood floor repairs. They are expecting bids on these items and will return to the April 1, 2024, Council meeting with an update on this phase.

Dave Carlstedt updated the council on Solid Waste Bids. He stated three bids were received and the Solid Waste Committee will be reviewing the bids to select the best option for the city.
