APPROVAL OF MINUTES

OLD BUSINESS

Ordinance 2024-8 (An Ordinance Levying a Property Tax and Tangible Property Tax for the City of Wilmore, Kentucky for the Year 2024) 1st Reading – Councilmember Brumfield made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Deyer to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2024-8. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.

Ordinance 2024-9 (An Ordinance Levying Ad Valorem Property Tax on all Motor Vehicles by the City of Wilmore, Kentucky for the Year 2024) 1st Reading – Councilmember Riel made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Deyer, to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2024-9. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.

NEW BUSINESS

Mayor Rainwater and Police Chief ShROUT requested that a 2004 Chevrolet Impala being used as a police department service vehicle be declared as surplus. Mayor Rainwater indicated it would be to the city's advantage to pay the police administrator mileage than maintain and insure the vehicle. Councilmember Bathje made the motion, seconded by Councilmember Riel, to declare the vehicle as surplus. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.


