April 21, 2025

The Wilmore City Council convened for a regular session on Monday, April 21, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., with Mayor Harold Rainwater presiding. Present were Councilmembers Leonard Fitch, Jim Brumfield, David Riel, Andy Bathje, Wes Metcalfe, Sharon Moore, and City Attorney Bobby Gullette, Jr.
