

CITY OF WILMORE MINUTES OCTOBER 6, 2025

The Wilmore City Council convened for a regular session on Monday, October 6, 2025, at 6:00 p.m., with Mayor Harold Rainwater presiding. Present were Councilmembers Leonard Fitch, Jim Brumfield, David Riel, Wes Metcalfe, Sharon Moore, and City Attorney Robert Gullette, Jr.

Approval of Minutes

Councilmember Riel moved, seconded by Councilmember Brumfield, to approve the minutes of September 15, 2025. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.

Mayor's Report

Mayor Rainwater informed the council that Asbury University will host the NCCA Outdoor Track and Field Championships in 2026 and 2027. He noted that these events will coincide with Wilmore's Sesquicentennial celebrations sponsored by the city.

Old Business

New Business

Mayor Rainwater requested council approval for a \$2,000 investment to gravel and install signage on a lot at 105 South Maple Street, owned by Brian Denger and Larry Lewis. The property will be available for city use as event parking. Councilmember Brumfield moved, with a second by Councilmember Metcalfe, to approve the \$2,000 expenditure for the improvements. There being no discussion, all members voted aye.

Nick Howard, with GRW Engineering Firm, asked the council to approve a bid of \$700,000 from The Allen Company, Inc. for the Main Street and Lexington Avenue Sewer Improvement Project. Councilmember Brumfield moved, seconded by Councilmember Moore, to approve the bid. There was no discussion, all members voted aye.
