April 20, 2026

The Wilmore City Council convened a regular session on Monday, April 20, 2026, at 6:00 p.m., with Mayor Pro Tem Sharon Moore presiding. Present were Councilmembers Leonard Fitch, Jim Brumfield, David Riel, Andy Bathje, Wes Metcalfe, and City Attorney Robert Gullette, Jr.

Approval of Minutes

Councilmember Riel moved, seconded by Councilmember Brumfield, to approve the minutes of April 6, 2026. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.

Mayor's Report

Councilmember Leonard Fitch presented the Wilmore Business Award to Tammy Gobel of Shades of the Bluegrass.

New Business

RESOLUTION 2026-2 A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF WILMORE TO APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE THROUGH THE INFRASTRUCTURE REVOLVING FUND (FUND B – STATE REVOLVING LOAN PROGRAM) AND DESIGNATING THE MAYOR AS THE OFFICIAL PROJECT REPRESENTATIVE-

Mayor Pro Tem Sharon Moore requested Council approval to designate Mayor Rainwater as the official project representative. Councilmember Brumfield moved, seconded by Councilmember Bathje, to approve the Resolution 2026-2. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.

RESOLUTION 2026-3 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF WILMORE, KENTUCKY APPOINTING MEMBERS TO THE CITY ETHICS BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH CITY OF WILMORE ORDINANCE NO. 2026-1-

Mayor Pro Tem Sharon Moore requested Council approval of Mayor Rainwater's recommendations for the five members of the Ethics Board. Councilmember Riel moved, seconded by Councilmember Fitch, to approve the Resolution 2026-3. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.

AUTHORIZATION TO ALLOW MAYOR RAINWATER TO SIGN THE KENTUCKY INFRASTRUCTURE AUTHORITY ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT-

Mayor Pro Tem Sharon Moore requested the council's approval to authorize Mayor Rainwater to sign the agreement. Councilmember Brumfield moved, seconded by Councilmember Riel, to approve. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.

Request to surplus a 2016 Dodge Charger – Nelson Shroul requested approval to surplus a 2016 Dodge Charger that has been replaced with a new vehicle. The council stipulated that the vehicle must be sold for at least \$3,000. Councilmember Brumfield moved, seconded by Councilmember Bathje and Councilmember Metcalfe, to approve. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.

Memorandum of Understanding with Jessamine County Code Enforcement establishing authority in Wilmore – Attorney Robert Gullette, Jr. Councilmember Riel moved, seconded by Councilmember Brumfield to approve. There was no discussion. All members voted aye.
